

ORDINANCE No. 106

An ordinance to vacate 23rd Street between Avenue "F" and Avenue "G", the alley through Block Thirteen (13) and the alley through Block Fourteen (14) and the lot lines in both Blocks Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14) in Lakeview Addition, all in the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, and to repeal all ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska:

SECTION I. Whereas, Esther Blazer, Buelah Blazer Kruse and Annie Blazer and William L. Knoles, owners of the land and lots in Block Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14) in Lakeview Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, have filed a petition asking that the alleys and lots lines in said Blocks be vacated and that 23rd street between Avenue "F" and Avenue "G" in said City be vacated and it appears that said land is at present being used for agricultural purposes, that none of the streets and alleys through or adjacent to said land have been open to the public and that the owners thereof anticipate the sub-division of said tract for the purpose of more advantageously constructing residences thereon and that we deem it advantageous and best for the interest of the City to vacate said street, alleys and lot lines, now, therefore,

SECTION II. The alleys through Blocks Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14) and the lot lines in said block as heretofore platted are hereby wholly and entirely vacated and 23rd Street from the east boundary of Avenue "F" to the west boundary of Avenue "G" within the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, is hereby vacated and that said alleys and said street so vacated shall revert to the owners of lots or lands abutting the same in proportion to the respective ownership of such lots or grounds.

SECTION III. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same hereby are repealed.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
