

ORDINANCE # 114

An Ordinance of the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, to Amend Ordinance No. 26 Relating to the Regulation of the Sale of Alcoholic Beverages, and Repealing All Ordinances or Parts of Ordinances in Conflict Therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section No. 1 of Ordinance No. 26 be amended to read as follows:

That section No. 1 of Ordinance No. 22 which was passed and approved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, July 2nd, 1935, shall be amended as follows:

No person or persons shall within such City sell at retail any Alcoholic Liquors including Beer on the Day of Any National, County or Municipal election, including primary elections, during the time the Polls are open in said city. No person or persons shall within such City sell at retail any Alcoholic Liquors, including Beer, on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to sell Alcoholic Liquors, including Beer, within such City on secular days between the hours of 10 o'clock P. M. and 7 o'clock A. M., provided, however, that on Saturdays, such Liquors, including Beer, may be sold until the hour of 11:00 o'clock P.M.

Section 2. That this ordinance be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as by law required. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
