

O R D I N A N C E # 144

An Ordinance to vacate the North-South alley of Block Nine (9), Hyde Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska and to repeal all ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOTHENBURG, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Whereas Block Nine (9) of Hyde Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Nebraska, contains an alley running from North to South and also contains an alley running East and West from the west side of said block to the North-South alley; and whereas it is not necessary to have such a large area in said block devoted to alleys and that it would be for the best interest of said City if the North-South alley were vacated.

SECTION 2. That the North-South alley in Block Nine (9), Hyde Park Addition to the City of Gothenburg, Dawson County, Nebraska, is hereby vacated.

SECTION 3. The alley so vacated herein shall revert to the owners of lands or lots abutting thereto.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
